Pop-Up Banner Setup & Takedown Instructions

Bicentennial Event Display Guide

Before You Begin

- All banners and carrying bags are labeled by number and banner title.
- Check you have all parts before setup:
 - Labeled banner(s)
 - Base(s) with pole(s) inside or attached
 - Carrying bags

Setup Instructions (IN ORDER)

1. Unload carefully

Remove banners and bases from the Bicentennial semi-trailer. Keep bags with each banner to avoid mix-ups.

2. Locate the labels

Each banner and base are numbered (e.g., Banner #1, Banner #2, etc.) for correct order and messaging flow. Lay them out in sequence.

3. Assemble the base and pole

- Open the banner base if needed.
- Insert and extend the pole vertically from the back center of the base. Most poles are telescoping—extend fully and lock.

4. Raise the banner

- Pull the banner slowly from the base.
- Attach the top rail of the banner to the top of the pole using the hook or clip provided.
- Be gentle—do not force or let go suddenly.
- 5. **Repeat for remaining banners** in numbered order.

6. Adjust for alignment

Once all banners are up, make sure they are aligned straight and evenly spaced for the best visual effect.

Takedown Instructions

1. Lower banners slowly

- Detach the top rail from the pole.
- Let the banner retract *slowly and with control* into the base to avoid damage.

2. Collapse the pole

Fold or retract the pole and place it back into the base or the carrying bag.

3. Return to labeled bags

- Each banner and base should go back into its labeled carrying bag.
- Ensure bags are zipped or secured.

4. Load back into the trailer

 Place the banners and bags in the designated storage area in the back of the Bicentennial semi-trailer.

Handling Reminders

- Do not bend or fold banners.
- Avoid placing them on wet or dirty ground.
- Always handle the retracting mechanism with care.
